By One Month of age, does your baby...

- 1. Look at you?
- 2. Startle to loud or sudden noise?
- 3. Calm down when comforted?
- 4. Suck well on the nipple?

By Two Months of age, does your baby...

- 1. Follow movement with eyes?
- 2. Study your face?
- 3. Startle or wake to loud noises?
- 4. Stop crying when comforted by you?
- 5. Enjoy being touched and cuddled?
- 6. Recognize and calm down to familiar gentle voice?
- 7. Have different cries (e.g. tired, hungry)?
- 8. Have a variety of sounds (e.g. coos, gurgles)?
- 9. Suck well on the nipple?
- 10. Feed every 2-4 hours during the day?
- 11. Lift head when on tummy? (Picture A)*
- 12. Hold head up when held at your shoulder? (Picture B)
- 13. Move arms and legs?
