


		1.	Turn head from side to side to follow a toy?
		2.	Glance from one object to another?
		3.	Turn head toward a source of sound?
		4.	Make some sounds when looking at toys or people?
		5.	Brighten to sound, especially to people's voices?
		6.	Respond to you by making sounds and moving arms and legs?
		7.	Laugh and smile at you?
		8.	Finish each feeding within 45 minutes?
		9.	Lift head and support self on forearms? (Picture A)*
		10.	Bring both hands to chest and keep head in midline when lying on back? (Picture B)
		11.	Hold head steady when supported in a sitting position?
		12.	Reach for an object when supported in a sitting position (e.g. sitting in an infant chair or on your lap)?
		13.	Hold an object briefly when placed in hand?
